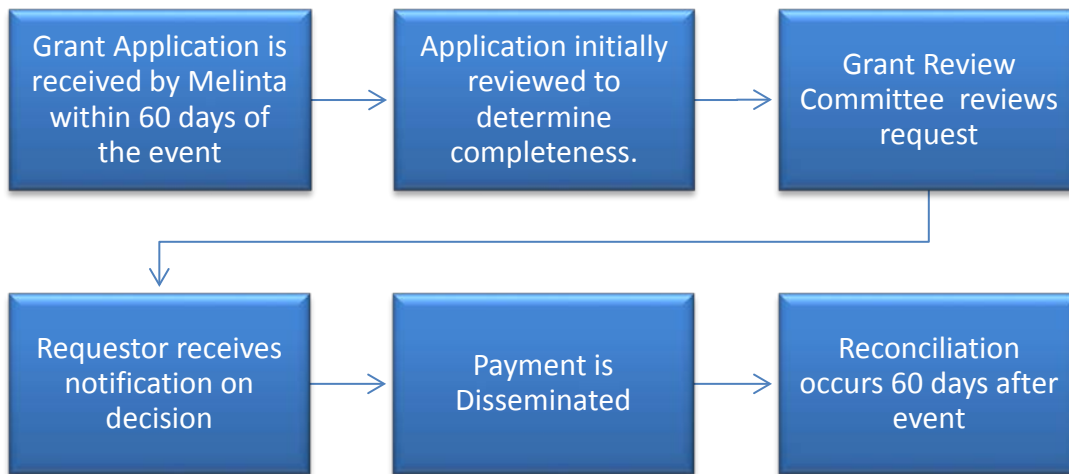

 - Please describe in detail specifically how this gap will be addressed.

- Who is the intended audience?
